Gift Aid

This form allows you to set up a standing order to make a donation to Cheltenham & District Samaritans each month. This money will be used to help with the running of the branch and allow it to continue to support the despairing and suicidal.

If in addition to your donation, you can make a gift aid declaration, we can claim back the tax you paid on the money you are donating. This is in effect a way of increasing the value of your donation courtesy of the Government. Currently every ten pounds you gift aid to Cheltenham Samaritans, is worth £12.80 to us.

For this gift aid agreement to take effect we need you to complete the standing order mandate to the right and to sign the declaration below. This has been designed to be as simple as possible whilst still meeting the requirements of the Inland Revenue.
